

4. Since July, some partners of the ECOHOL project have started showcasing the project in multiplier event and national conferences.


All great occasion to meet with young entrepreneurs, students evolving in the field of tourism, policy makers and people from the tourism industry.

For the participants it was a great occasion to network among each other and discover a european project.






